Philip Nord is a modern European historian with an interest in the politics and culture of France. His books include studies of the social bases of anti-Dreyfusism, the coming of the Third Republic, the politics of Impressionism, and the remaking of the French state at the Liberation. He has just completed a volume revisiting France’s “strange defeat” in 1940 titled, *France 1940: Defending the Republic*. His current project deals with how to narrate and represent the experience of Deportation in France after the Second World War.
